

Proclamation

In Recognition of the Mayors' Monarch Pledge and National Pollinator Week

- WHEREAS,** the monarch butterfly is an iconic pollinator species whose population has declined by 90% in the last 20 years; and
- WHEREAS,** pollinator species are essential to food production. They provide significant environmental benefits necessary for maintaining healthy ecosystems, water quality, air quality, coastal stability, and wildlife populations; and
- WHEREAS,** bees, butterflies, and other pollinators abundant in public and private landscapes are an indicator of biodiversity. They are aesthetically pleasing and engage people of all backgrounds to connect and support wildlife where they live, work, play, and worship; and
- WHEREAS,** Mayor Seiler signed the National Wildlife Federation's Mayor's Monarch Challenge on May 13th, 2016, becoming the 150th leader in the nation to pledge habitat creation for monarchs and for citizen education regarding the plight of the monarch butterfly; and
- WHEREAS,** on April 19th, 2016 the city of Fort Lauderdale became the 86th National Wildlife Federation Community Wildlife Habitat in the nation with more than 400 Certified Wildlife Habitat properties in our city; and
- WHEREAS,** supporting habitat creation for the monarch butterfly is in line with the White House's Executive Strategy to "Promote the Health of Honey Bees and Other Pollinators" as well as both the National Wildlife Federation's Certified Wildlife Habitat and Mayors' Monarch Pledge programs. The creation of pollinator gardens also count toward the National Pollinator Gardens Network Million Pollinator Garden Challenge.

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, as City Commissioners of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, do hereby proclaim the week of **June 20-26, 2016** as:

Fort Lauderdale Pollinator Week

and encourage all neighbors to help restore habitat for the monarch butterfly by planting native milkweed and other native nectar plants so that these magnificent pollinators will once again flourish across the continent.
